



College Preparation Timeline








Consent to Release






Important Steps For Students

- Finalize Your College List (Choose @ least 3 schools;
 one should be Likely*)
- Submit your <u>Consent Form/Transcript Requests</u>
- Talk to your counselor to request a recommendation
- Use a tracking tool that works for you
- Pay attention to deadlines
- Utilize <u>Naviance</u> & <u>Schoology: Senior Folder</u>







Paying for College/Financial Aid

- Register for an <u>FSA ID</u>, which serves as your FAFSA e-signature.
- If you are attending a college that requires it, complete the <u>CSS Profile</u>
- Watch for Financial Aid events in December or January.
- Complete the <u>FAFSA</u> when it opens in December.







Paying for College/Scholarships

- Consider colleges that offer merit scholarships
 Be sure to research any deadline associated
 with these school-based merit scholarships.
- Search for scholarships on <u>Naviance</u>, the FCPS college & career platform.
- Check out other scholarship websites as well, such as <u>FastWeb</u> and <u>Niche</u>







SAT/ACT & Test Optional

If you choose to send scores, be aware of the following:

- Westfield <u>does not</u> send SAT/ACT scores
- Students can request scores directly through their account @ College Board or ACT

If you don't want to submit your scores or do not plan on taking the SAT or ACT

 Check college websites, Naviance, or <u>FairTest</u> to confirm test optional status
